Helping High School Seniors Pursue Higher Education

DMCU loves to do charitable work and give back to the communities in which it serves. Now, we want to take it a step further and provide our members with assistance in their pursuit of higher education. We are offering three college scholarships of \$2,500 each to eligible members* who are high school seniors (one each from our Detroit Main/CAYMC, Clawson and Novi branches). See eligibility requirements below.

Scholarship Rules:

Eligibility

- o Must be a DMCU member and all accounts must be in good standing.
- Must be accepted by a university, college, or trade school for the fall 2020 semester in the United States of America.

Requirements and Supporting Documentation

- Compose an essay of 500 words or more describing your involvement in the community, school, family, and your future aspirations. Be sure to include why you think credit unions are important to their communities.
- o Provide two formal letters of recommendation from someone other than a family member (one must be from a teacher or supervisor).
- o Provide official current high school transcripts.
- o Provide college, university, or trade school acceptance letter and course schedule.

Deciding Factors

- o Grade point average.
- Extracurricular involvement in school, community, religious, and other recognizable organizations.
- o Employment history.
- o Content of the written essay must discuss the importance of credit unions.

Deadline

o May 15, 2020.

Applications and all supporting documents must be submitted by May 15, 2020. Winners will be announced on June 5, 2020. Scholarship funds will be disbursed by August 3, 2020. The check will be made payable to the college/university. DMCU cannot disclose information to parents of applicants who are not a joint on the account.
